

## Passenger Flight Guide

### Flight Guidelines and Policies:

- Passengers are restricted to those 12 years age and older who are capable of understanding the aircraft safety features and the emergency procedures to be conveyed to them during the preflight briefing.
- A “Waiver and Liability Exclusion Agreement” must be signed prior to the flight. For passengers 12 to 17 years of age the “Waiver and Liability Exclusion Agreement must be signed by a parent or guardian”.
- Flight bookings are made on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Flight fare includes admission\* for passenger and one spectator accompanying to the museum during normal business hours only. All other spectator’s accompanying the passenger, admission fees apply. (\*not valid during special events (ie: Annual Aviation Days).
- Additional persons accompanying passenger on flighty day, regular admission fee plus taxes is applicable
- Coupons, passes and discounts are not valid during special events.



### Scheduling of flights:

- Tiger Moth Flights (ride) available May 1 through October 1 (weather and pilot availability dependent).
- To book a flight, please call ahead (306-651-7247) to arrange an available date and time.
- Up to **3 days prior to the flight** schedule, this date will be confirmed directly with the passenger.

### Flight conditions:

- All flights are dependent upon favorable weather, wind and temperature.
- When Mother Nature does not cooperate and your flight is unable to take off due to weather/wind conditions, it may be necessary to reschedule your flight.
- Pilots will advise and staff will discuss alternative dates with you when this occurs.
- On the day of the scheduled flight. Please, call ahead and inquire on flight status (weather or delays).

### Flight day - How to prepare:

- Reasonable closed toe, soft-soled footwear is suggested. You’re climbing onto, into and out of aircraft.
- Temperatures can be cooler at higher altitudes dependent on the day. Dress for the weather of the day.
- Please **arrive 20 minutes** prior to your scheduled flight time for check-in, document signing and briefings.
- **If you have a Gift Certificate, please bring it with you.**

### Upon arriving at the Saskatchewan Aviation Museum:

- Please check-in with the front office staff.
- Payment must be completed.

- A “Waiver and Liability Exclusion Agreement” **must** be signed prior to the flight.
- Admission for one spectator accompanying the passenger is included in the passenger’s flight fare
- All other spectator’s accompanying the passenger, regular admission fees apply.
- Persons accompanying you will be directed to where they may safely view the aircraft.
- You will be accompanied by the Ground Crew to the aircraft area and introduced to the pilot.
- Please listen and follow all instructions from your ground crew and pilot
- After a pre-flight briefing from the Ground Crew or Pilot and a walk round of the aircraft, the pilot will assist you to climb into the cockpit and prepare for your flight.
- The flight is 20 minutes in the air then return for landing and taxi back to the hangar.

**End of Flight:**

- Follow your pilot’s instructions. They will assist you out of the airplane and direct you accordingly.
- Our Ground Crew will greet you once back at the hangar and assist answering your questions.
- Please sign and leave a comment your experience in the planes “flight log book”.
- If you choose to take a tour of the museum after your flight, our tour guides will accompany you.
- Please take a moment to browse our gift shop for mementos.
